#### **Your Presentation**

- You have 20 minutes. Think about dividing the time between the two of you.
  - Try to do your best. Don't forget: you will get a grade for this!
- After your presentation we will discuss in the time left:
  - The delivery. We will follow the structure given in the <u>check\_list</u>.
  - The content. Everybody may ask questions to your topic. Be prepared!

### **Your Paper**

- The Rules for writing your paper are extremely simple:
  - You follow exactly and without exception the format for some <u>camera-ready manuscript</u> for some <u>proceedings</u>.
  - You will find these instructions in this link. These instructions, by the way look exactly as your manuscript is going to look if you do it right.
  - The page limit is 3 pages
  - Here was an example from the previous year.
- The simplest way to do this is to download the example and to use it directly as your formatted word document. Erase and replace and be sure that you don't exchange the format when you copy something from a different format and paste it into your paper!

# **Your Referee Report**

- You (as a group or as individuals) will write a referee report to the papers of the other groups.
  - You follow the format in the <u>link</u>
  - Be critical! This Seminar has a rejection rate of > 60 % (just kidding; but that's what many journals tell you).
